Diagnosis:

In March of 2004, Zeke was diagnosed with a severe brain injury due to symptoms from a severe and unusual case of bacterial pneumonia. Upon leaving the hospital, Zeke was cortically blind, immobile, insensate (unable to feel), rigid, not able to swallow, fed through a g-tube, irritable, constantly crying.

Zeke's 2010 Accomplishments:

Zeke's huge victory this year was the elimination of his feeding tube. He eats and drinks all meals orally. He proved the doctors wrong. Way to go!

Since learning and implementing a new therapy this year called ABR, Zeke lifts his head up longer, is crawling/wiggling more on the floor, laughs more frequently, and is more visually aware. ABR works on his physical structure/core to allow him to function better.

Zeke does aqua therapy in Schreiber's Pediatric pool. He loves moving freely in the water without the pressure of gravity. Going under the water is an accomplishment for him, as well.

Zeke enjoys watching the Phillies, reading and facilitated writing with mom. Thanks to your support Zeke has the privilege to continue therapies that improve his development.
